Kathmandu. This hospital which was established on February 22, 2007 by Mr. Y u s h u n Masunaga, the Patron of the hospital and Eurasia Reiyukai F o u n d e r President, has up



to this day provided services to 1 lakh 5 thousand and 31 patients through itself and the camps organized under it. It has through several camps organized frequently in different districts including Bhaktapur, Kavrepalanchowk, Sindhupalchowk and Sindhuli, treated innumerable persons on the verge of losing eyesight in the distance villages. Thanks to the special support of the B.P. Koirala Lions Eyes Study Centre at Maharajguni, Dr. Sagun Narayan Joshi, Dr. Madhu Thapa, Dr. Gulsan Bahadur Shrestha, Dr. Pragati Gautam and Dr. Irina Kansakar have been contributing significant cooperation to the development of the hospital. The hospital staff and management are proud of putting into practice their spirit of making contribution to the society as much as they could by organizing at least three camps every month for the benefit of the community. The hospital has until now had the opportunity of bringing back to the bright world the life that was heading towards the dark one, by doing cataract operation upon 2,306 persons. In view of the present building very much congested for providing free services to the patients, the hospital has purchased a plot of land and is now contemplating to construct a new building. In this connection the Eurasia Reiyukai Founder President, Mr. Yushun Masunaga, who is the Patron of this hospital, laid the foundation, on April 30, 2012, of the new building in Banepa amidst a grand function. After the completion of the building as many as 300 patients are expected to receive service every day.

# 42nd Memorial Ceremony of Mahaguru Mrs. Kimi Kotani


